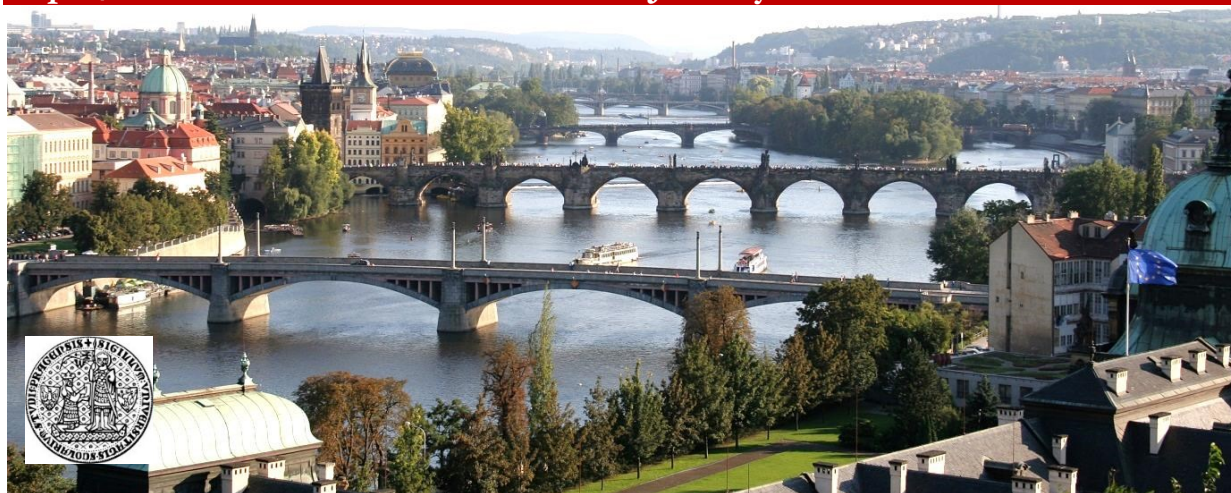
# Turkish Migration Conference 2015

Renowned author **Nedim Gürsel** from CNRS, France will also join us as an invited speaker in these special sessions.
